

Sermon Discussion Questions
July 20, 2025

1. What do you treasure most in life—and how can you tell?

What does the way you spend your time, money, attention, or energy reveal about what you truly value? How might Jesus' parables challenge or affirm that?

2. Have you ever "stumbled" into an experience of God or spiritual insight, like the man in the field?

Or, are you more like the pearl merchant—searching, discerning, longing for something deeper? How does your story connect with one of these parables?

3. Jesus says the Kingdom is worth giving up everything for. What would it actually look like to live as if that's true?

In what specific ways might God be inviting you—or our church—to let go of “lesser treasures” in order to take hold of something far greater?

4. How has the Kingdom of God already impacted your everyday life?

Think about work, relationships, how you handle failure or success, or how you engage with justice and mercy. Where do you see the treasure of the Kingdom breaking in?

5. Who around you needs to be offered this treasure—and how can you begin to give it away?

What keeps us from sharing the Kingdom with our friends, family, or neighbors? What would it look like for you to joyfully give away what you've found?
