



## Sermon Discussion Questions: April 12, 2026

### *How to be a Disciple*

Sermon Series: Learning the Way of Jesus

Passage: Mark 6:7-13

1. When we think about showing people the heart of God by serving them, that requires sacrifices. Often, the things that fundamentally keep us from serving others are our own values. First, what do you and your family value that requires a lot of your extra time (sports, music lessons, work functions, personal time, vacations)?
2. Connected to the question above, who are people that you see, think of, or hear about regularly who are hurting and need to be loved? Are there any values you mentioned before that you could give up to make time for that person? If you had more time, what are practical ways that you could serve them?
3. When you think about telling people the good news, who is doing the work to change their heart (Mark 4:26-29)? How does that change the pressure you feel when sharing the good news? Why?
4. When you think of sharing the good news with others, what does that look like in your head? If we thought outside the box of what we typically consider “evangelism”, what could telling people the good news look like? How could your family, your home, your community group, and your devotional routine play a role in that work?
5. Warning people about their standing with God feels incredibly challenging. What challenges come to mind when you consider this? Who are the particular people you wish you could warn if it weren’t so challenging?
6. How can you navigate those challenges to help them see the love of God calling them to come back to him, rather than the judgement of God wagging a disapproving finger at them?
