

## Sermon Discussion Questions: June 7, 2026

### *Pressing Toward Jesus*

Sermon Series: Running the Race of Faith

Passage: Hebrews 1:1-4

1. Why do you think the original readers of Hebrews were tempted to drift away from Jesus?

**Follow-up:** What pressures or distractions make it difficult for Christians today to keep following Jesus faithfully?

2. The sermon emphasized that spiritual growth happens by "looking at Jesus and never stopping." What does that practically look like in everyday life?

**Follow-up:** What habits, relationships, or practices help you keep Jesus at the center of your attention?

3. Hebrews opens by declaring that God has spoken most fully through his Son. Why is it important that Christianity is centered on a person rather than simply a set of teachings or rules?

**Follow-up:** How does seeing Jesus as God's final and fullest revelation change the way you read the Bible or approach your faith?

4. The sermon described Jesus as God's transforming power at work in us. Can you identify a season when focusing on Christ changed your perspective, priorities, or character?

**Follow-up:** Where do you most need his transforming work in your life right now?

5. The preacher said that the church exists to make Jesus known and to see lives transformed by him. How does keeping Jesus at the center shape the mission of a church?

**Follow-up:** What opportunities has God given you to help make Jesus known among your family, friends, neighbors, or coworkers?

### **Optional Closing Question:**

After hearing this sermon, what is one practical way you can "keep looking at Jesus" this week?
